How the Decathlon Works

Each completed sheet earns you the prize listed on the sheet.

You may complete as many sheets as you like, in any subject or combination of subjects.

(Example: If you spend all break doing nothing but science labs, you can keep earning the prize for science labs over and over again.)

The Decathlon is a bonus prize for exceptional effort across all subjects.

To complete the Decathlon you must complete one sheet in each of the ten subjects. (You can do more, of course.)

Decathlon competitors may optionally choose to skip one subject in exchange for completing two additional sheets in any other subjects.

(Example 1: You could skip Science Labs, and do two additional sheets in History.)

(Example 2: You could skip Fine Arts, and do one additional sheet in Crafts and one additional sheet in Science Reading.)

If there is any doubt about whether your work counts towards a prize, get parent preapproval before you begin.

Prize Equivalents: When you earn a prize, you can choose a pre-approved equivalent prize instead.

Fine Arts

Spend a total of five hours working on any combination of fine arts projects.

Approved fine arts are: Penmanship, calligraphy, drawing, painting, singing, or learning (practicing) a musical instrument. You may request approval for other fine arts.

Crafts

Spend a total of five hours working on any combination of craft projects.

Approved crafts include but are not limited to: Sewing, woodworking, scrapbooking, knitting, crochet, and household repairs. Other crafts will be considered, but get parent approval first before beginning to make sure you get credit.

If you have already completed at least one Fine Arts sheet, you may use additional Fine Arts time on your craft sheet.

Spend a total of five hours working on any combination of projects to clean or improve our home.

All projects must be pre-approved in order to get credit.

Regular daily chores do not count.

Some projects may count for either "crafts" or "home and garden help", but each 15 minutes can only be counted one time.

Don't be shy: We're open to any cleaning or maintenance job that needs to be done, concerning anything that is ours to maintain.

Volunteer work for others or for shared spaces (example: picking up litter in public areas) can count as well.

Bible Verse Memory

Hymn or Poem Memorization

Choose a hymn or poem you have not already memorized.

Longer works can earn a second sheet or part of a second sheet.

Shorter works can be combined to complete a sheet.
